

Investigating the measure satisfaction of job prospects of teacher-students of physical education of Farhangian University

Background: positive attitude toward future job will have made job motivation and it will also lead to job success[1]. If one person is not interested in his job, continuing to work would be tedious and even impossible[2]. The purpose of this research was study to investigate the measure satisfaction of job prospects of teacher-students of physical education of Farhangian University.

Method: This is a descriptive survey research. The statistical Society is the students of physical education of Farhangian University in 93-94; among which 161 people were chosen via random sampling as the statistical sample. We collected data by a questionnaire which contained 17 questions with the 5-point Likert. For the validity of research, content validity and face validity; also for the reliability of the research, Cronbach's alpha were utilized which was at an acceptable level of 77%. Spss 16 was used for data analysis. Data were analyzed by using t-test.

Results: There are different views in students of Farhangian University to their job prospect, in a way that female students than males, married than singles, sophomores than juniors and students with higher averages have more positive views. At the end we can point to this subject that teacher-students of physical education of Farhangian University have positive mentality about their satisfaction of job prospects and its result is job satisfaction and much inside motivation which this motivation is affective motivation for start and continuation teaching profession.
